	above a 4.0 overall WIDA ACCESS score they often could not distinguish a student as proficient or not proficient.	
	 Based on levels above a 4.0 WIDA ACCESS score, many students score at a level 3 or 4 on the SBA ELA. 	
	 The proposal is for students in grades 3-12 who score at a 4.3 to 4.6 WIDA ACCESS and also score a 3 or 4 on the SBA ELA to be able to exit ELD services.

	Members were in agreement that this would be a good change to the exit criteria and that it would have a positive effect on students.
